## President's Corner

The Sky's the Limit Land Acquisition Celebration was a great public relations success for our club and other groups who participated. We were blessed that a strong storm broke up before it could have soaked us, then the winds calmed and the sun shined.

At our last monthly meeting we approved a draft that I wrote to add a quorum requirement to our bylaws. I am going to take this opportunity to advertise this proposed addition to our bylaws.

At the next monthly meeting on June 3, 2016, if there are 20 members present, I am going to ask for a vote of affirmation for this addition to our bylaws.

### Article X - Quorum Requirements

A minimum of 18 members must be present at a meeting for decisions to be made.

Motions made, and advanced to a vote without a quorum present must be (1) advertised to the club members, (2) held over to the next regular club meeting, (3) require a majority vote of those in attendance at the meeting.

There is no quorum requirement for items that were held over from the previous meeting and advertised to the club members. This includes fund appropriations in excess of \$300. There was a motion to spend \$400 for the Giant Scale Event.

I ask for your support on this issue and encourage you all to attend as many meetings as you can. Your opinion matters, the meeting is where it will be heard.

The meeting was held at 9:30 on April 30 at the Eagles Landing Restaurant. Three members of the EC were present along with the President, Vice-President, Secretary and Newsletter Staff. There were discussions on "The Sky's the Limit" program as well as a discussion on cones at the field and flags near the flight line. In addition there was a discussion on a possible change in the by-laws regarding quorums.

The Executive Committee voted to recommend that the cones would be removed after the line painting was completed and two small flags would be placed in the grass barriers to aid in wind direction recognition. The EC also voted to recommend that a quorum to conduct new Club business would be 20 members unless the item was carried over from a previous meeting and advertised in the newsletter.

### Old Business:

MikeB: Question about MFP fund raising count. MikeE stated that park miscounted MVRC funds raised and is not going to pursue this year but Club will keep accurate count next year. Official MFP funds raised in 2016 is \$2385 / \$1500 of which was donated by the club.

MikeE: Suggested plan for establishing a number for a quorum at reg meetings to do business...bylaw change.

A discussion took place. Motion was made to establish the quorum at 18 members needed to vote on business at regular meeting.

Motion carried 12+/6- . Motion must now be approved by 2/3 majority of 20 for a bylaw change. 13 votes needed.

According to Roberts Rules a new quorum number can be established for each meeting as long as it's advertised to the membership before that meeting.

Moderated a discussion about flagsticks and cones.

BobH: Made a motion to table the vote on cones. Motion did not carry. 8+ / 10-

JeffD: Made motion for 6 flagsticks with flags and foam noodles to be place in high grass barriers.

Motion carried with 12+ votes / fyi: 2 members had exited the meeting before the vote.

## Show 'N Tell... 1000mm Scratch Built Quad...Lew Marascalco



Lew Marascalco presented his 1 meter (diagonal distance between motor centers) "H" multi-rotor. It is his own design and presently in a preliminary state of completion. Electronics have yet to be installed and tested in anticipation of first test flight. Motors are 4108, 22 pole, 580kv and props are 14x5 carbon fiber. Flying weight with a 6s 5000mah lipo pack will be about 5 pounds.


